



The 2 bedroom / 4 person loft floor plan is one of the more common types of apartment that will be available in UV. It is small and efficient, with an economical rent to match. There is no living room, just a small kitchen, a private bath, and two bedrooms for two residents with beds lofted over the desks and dressers.

The above room types will be available in different buildings in the Village, but will have the same rent, regardless of in which building they are located.

Almost 1850 upperclassmen will call USC Village home, living in four large apartment buildings, each a residential college. (The theme and program for these residential colleges are still being determined.) A full complement of Residential Education staff and residential faculty will live in the building to facilitate activities and programs.

A wide variety of room type will be available: 1 bedroom units for 2 or 3 residents, 2 bedroom units for 3 or 4 residents and 3 bedroom units for 6 residents, with rent prices to meet almost every student budget. All apartments are fully furnished and air-conditioned.

Residents will have a partial meal plan, which will be accepted at the new on-site dining hall as well as other campus dining venues.
